At the same time, the Head of Communications will continue to build our reputation with existing and potential donors, and within the air quality community.

The successful candidate will bring significant experience of developing and implementing communication strategies. The ideal candidate will be a self-starter with an instinctive problem-solving approach and be passionate about achieving the Clean Air Fund's objectives. Most importantly, they will be an excellent and engaging written communicator, whilst being supremely organised and experienced at working across teams and external stakeholders. An awareness of environmental and/or health issues will be beneficial.
